THE DFWI 500+ CLUB RULES

1. To be known as THE DFWI 500+ Club (hereinafter called 'the Club') and to be registered at the Headquarters of the Devon Federation of Women's Institutes.
2. Participation in this Club is open to Devon Federation of Women's Institute members.
3. The Club is formed for fund raising purposes and all proceeds raised by the Club, after the provision of prizes and expenses, will be devoted to the objects of the DFWI (hereinafter called the Federation).
4. Applications for participation in the Club must be made to the Co-ordinator authorised by the Board of Trustees Committee of the Federation. The subscription shall be £5.00 per share per annum, the year being 1st January to 31st December.
5. There shall be a minimum of 300 units or shares, which can be held singly or in multiples. Every share must be registered in a single name. Every participant must be a member of the Federation upon receipt of their first payment to the Club and must remain a member of the Federation in order to participate.
6. Each WI will receive a copy of these rules and a registered number for each share held for the participants to refer to.
7. There will be draws for 50% of the capital deposit, after expenses have been deducted. The draws for the prizes to be arranged at the discretion of the Board of Trustees Committee in the presence of at least five persons.
8. Every member shall have access on request to a list of prize winners at least every half year.
9. Fully paid-up members of the Club are entitled to take part in all draws.
10. The decision of the Board of Trustees Committee of the Federation is final in any matter requiring adjudication. The Committee has the power to amend or revoke these rules after 28 days notice has been given to all members.
11. The Co-ordinator of the Club shall be a member of the Board of Trustees Committee for the time being of the Federation.
