## RULES

All exhibits will be judged within the guidelines laid down in the NFWI Handbook “**On with the Show**” 2015 edition. This can be viewed online at: [www.mywi.thewi.org.uk](http://www.mywi.thewi.org.uk) or at the WI office.

Closing date for entries: **Friday, 11 September 2020**

Work must be the bona fide work of the exhibitor. It must have been completed within the last two years and should not have been entered in any previous competition.

Only one entry per class per member. Entry fee = £1 per entry.

Please send entry forms, including appropriate entry fees, to the Federation Office (address on form). Please also confirm to the office that an entry form has been despatched, either by telephone or email (this due to occasional misdirection/loss of mail).

All entries to be brought to The Venue between 10.00am and 11.30am on Friday, 30 October 2020.

No more than **two** members from each WI will be admitted to The Venue to stage Class One (Co-operative) entries.

Please ensure there is nothing included in any exhibit which could identify the exhibitor. Exhibit labels will be provided prior to the event.

The judges’ decision is final. No correspondence will be entered into. Judges are invited, entirely at their discretion, to give written comments where possible.

The presentation of awards will take place at 3.00pm on the day of the Show (Saturday, 31<sup>st</sup> October 2020). No exhibits may be dismantled or removed before 3.30pm, when the Show closes.

Anyone arriving before 3pm will be charged the full entry fee.

## PHOTOGRAPHY

Unmounted, not to exceed 6ins x 4ins (15 x 10 cms)  
Must be original and taken by exhibitor

- 1 Fancy Dress/Face Paint Selfie
- 2 A Pet/Animal
- 3 Colourful colours

## FLOWERS

**An Arrangement - fresh flowers and foliage only**  
**An Exhibit = may include accessories**

- 1 A Corsage ready to wear (Exhibit)
- 2 Carnival Arrangement in Orange, Red & Yellow (Arrangement) – not to exceed 12 x 12 x 12ins (30 x 30 x 30cms)
- 3 Autumn Wreath on a 12ins (30 cms) wire ring (Exhibit)

## NOVICE CATEGORY

These classes are for members who are entering in that class for the first time. Rules are the same as other classes

- 1 Cookery: 3 decorated cup cakes (to be judged on decoration only)
- 2 Craft: A Bookmark – any medium
- 3 Art: “Clowns” – any medium
- 4 Cards: A Congratulations card – any medium
- 5 Flowers: An Arrangement in a small milk jug

## CO-OPERATIVE

**“COME TO THE CARNIVAL”**

One entry per WI

Items to be judged

- 1 Flower arrangement – fresh flowers and foliage only (seed heads may be used)
- 2 One item of craft work
- 3 One cookery item – to be judged on both taste and appearance; no meat, fish or cream

Exhibit to be judged from the front on a base not to exceed 2ft x 2ft (61.5 x 61.5cms), backing and side pieces optional and included in overall measurements. No height restriction. Accessories included in overall measurements. **No part of the exhibit should overhang the edges of the board on sides, front or back (if backboard not used).**

Flower arrangement to be brought ready for display.

No more than two members per WI to stage the exhibit between:

**10.00 and 11.30am on Friday, 30 October 2020**

Maximum marks: 100  
(ie 20 per item, 20 interpretation, 20 staging)

**Entry Fee: £5.00**

All entries will be accepted but if deemed not to comply with the rules they will not be judged

## COOKERY

All items to be home made

- 1 1lb/454g Jar of Lemon Curd
- 2 6 pieces of home made fudge (bite size)
- 3 3 Chocolate Chip Cookies
- 4 Victoria Sandwich using the recipe below

### Ingredients:

- 3 eggs and their weight in
- butter or margarine, caster sugar and self raising flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- Raspberry jam

### Method:

- Use either the creaming or the all-in-one method to combine the ingredients.
- Place in two 7in (20 cms) tins, greased and lined with greaseproof paper.
- Bake at 190 degrees C (375 degrees F, mark 5) for about 20 minutes.
- When cool sandwich together with the jam and sprinkle the top with caster sugar.
- Serve on a doily on a plate.

## CRAFT

All items to be home made

- 1 Venetian Carnival Mask – any medium
- 2 Knitted/Crocheted Carnival character – (max height 12 ins/30 cms)
- 3 Embroidered picture to fit into A5 frame
- 4 Decorated hair ornament – any medium
- 5 Fabric purse to be worn around neck – (2.75 x 5.5 x 0.3 ins/7.0 x 14.0 x 0.7 cms)

## ART

Entries may be any size but overall dimensions (including mount) must not exceed 12 x 17 ins (30 x 43 cms). Items should be unframed but mounted for hanging

- 1 Poster to advertise a Carnival – any medium (must include some wording)
- 2 The Carnival Parade – any medium
- 3 Jugglers – any medium

## CARDS

Cards not to exceed 6 x 8.5ins (15 x 21 cms)

- 1 Cross Stitch – “Carnival”
- 2 Invitation – “Come to the Carnival” – any medium
- 3 Iris Folding Birthday Card
