

# MAKE, BAKE & SHOW 2020

## HINTS & TIPS

### FEES

- Entry fee for Co-operative = £5
- Entry fee for individual entries = £1 per entry

### ALL CLASSES

- **Members may enter one item only per class but may enter as many classes as they wish.**
- Be sure to read the instructions and size limits carefully. These will be strictly adhered to in the judging and if your entry does not comply it will not be judged. Work not to schedule will remain on display but will be labelled “not to schedule”.
- Exhibits must not include anything that could identify the exhibitor. This could compromise the neutrality of judging. Entrants will be identified by a competitor number which will be shown on your exhibit labels.
- Exhibit labels will be provided in advance to your WI secretary.

### CO-OPERATIVE

- Please ensure you include a card specifying the items to be judged to avoid any confusion.
- When planning and executing your entry, do bear in mind that your exhibit should be able to withstand conditions within the hall for the duration of the Show, without need for attention.

### COOKERY

- Jars and/or lids must not bear trade names or other branding as this contravenes the Trade Descriptions Act.
- If twist top lids are used, these should be new.
- Jars must be clear glass
- Labels should state contents, and day, month and year of making
- Exhibits in Classes 2 and 3 should be displayed on a plain plate. Please be mindful that there is limited space available for display.
- Class 4 must be produced using the recipe provided.

### CRAFT

- Venetian Carnival Mask –for either adult or child to wear
- Embroidered picture (Class 3) cannot be cross stitch.
- Hair ornament (Class 4) must be fit for purpose.
- Length of cord for Fabric Purse (Class 5) is according to your preference. Dimensions refer to body of the purse only.

### ART

- Please be sure to comply with size limits
- Please ensure your exhibit is unframed and mounted for hanging

## **FLOWERS**

- Please note the difference between an Arrangement and an Exhibit and ensure you comply with the requirements.

## **NOVICE CATEGORY**

- These classes are open only to members who have never entered that particular class before, ie if you have previously entered an item for Craft in a Show, you may not enter that class in this category. However, if you have never entered a flower arrangement, then you are eligible to enter that class.
- Please note that you cannot enter the Novice Category if you have entered any other class at this Show.
- Please read carefully the requirements for each of the main Show categories. Those rules also apply to the Novice classes.
